Using Your Benefits at UCSB

How do I get started with my benefits?

If this is your first time applying for a benefit with the VA, you will need to apply online at www.vets.gov. After you've applied, the VA will mail you a Certificate of Eligibility (COE) within 30-45 business days.

I've received my COE; what are my next steps?

 You'll need to turn in your COE and a Veterans Benefit Request Form (VBRF). The VBRF can be found on the VMS website. Please email these forms to VeteransBenefits@sa.ucsb.edu.

Do I need to submit a VBRF every quarter?

 You must submit a new VBRF any time you register for classes, or make a change to your class schedule.

Is there a deadline to submit the VBRF?

 No, but it is recommended that you submit your VBRF as soon as you register for the following term.

What is the CalVet Fee Waiver, and how do I apply?

 The CalVet waiver is for dependents of veterans who are California residents. For more information and to apply, visit https://www.calvet.ca.gov/VetServices/ pages/college-fee-waiver.aspx

<u>I have my CalVet authorization letter; what are my next steps?</u>

 Email a copy of your letter to VeteransBenefits@sa.ucsb.edu. If you are using any other benefit along with the CalVet waiver, you'll need to turn in a VBRF as well.

<u>Do I need to reapply for the CalVet Waiver</u> each academic year?

 You must reapply every academic year you wish to use the waiver.
