Chapter III, Section A (2.) (c.) (Areas 1-5))

~ Please adhere to the following requirements ~

1. Music and amplification of sound (live bands, recorded music; including sound checks) is permitted in **Storke Plaza, SRB, Faculty Club Green, Lagoon Lawn** only from: 12:00 noon – 1:00 p.m. ONLY!
2. Voice amplification is allowed in **above facilities** from 11:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. ONLY!
3. Music and amplification volumes may not impede or interfere with the learning process.
4. Storke Plaza programs that offer amplification of any kind (music, speeches, performances, etc.) are required to have decibel (dB) sound measurements and/or readings by a staff member of the Office of Student Life.
  - a. Occupational Safety and Hazard Administration, OSHA, has determined that when sound measurements and/or readings exceed 90 dB, it is considered unsafe.
  - b. Failure to adhere to the 90 dB readings will result in forfeiture of use of above facilities for any and/or all of the following:
    - 1) Rest of the remaining quarter
    - 2) The following quarter
    - 3) The quarter one year to date of original offense
  - c. **\*Note:** Access to Storke Plaza is restricted due to the absence of roadways.
